

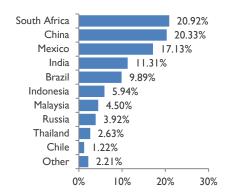
# **EMDD** | EGShares Emerging Markets Domestic Demand FTF

#### Reasons to Invest

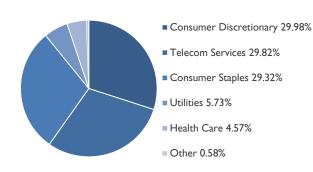

Price/Book Ratio is the total market value of all the portfolio's equity holdings divided by the sum of the book values of those securities. P/E Ratio (Trailing) is the sum of the reported earnings for the trailing 12-month earnings of the equity holdings, divided by the total market value of the equity holdings. Both positive and negative earnings are included in the calculation. Total Constituent Daily Traded Value is the sum of the six-month average daily traded value (in USD) of a fund's individual holdings.

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
